WELCOME

For the seventh time, we would like to invite you to the Silesia Rally - the most important motorsport event in our region. This year we have prepared many attractions for the fans and many new special sections for the competitors.

As in previous years, the rally will be based at the Silesian Stadium. This is where the competitors will set up their service stations, where the rally office will be located, and where the finishing ceremony will take place. The ceremonial start of the rally will take place on Friday, 8 September in Katowice - just like last year, the competitors will cross the ramp at the representative Dworcowa street, from where they will set off on the superOES route in the centre of Katowice, around the Culture Zone and Spodek.

On Saturday and Sunday, the Silesian Rally 2023 returns to the classic special stages in the south of the voivodeship. On the first day, in addition to the section in Jastrzębie-Zdrój, which is well known to the competitors, they will conquer the new sections Hażlach and Gmina Jasienica. Each of them will be completed twice, and on the section in Jastrzębie-Zdrój a part of the route will be additionally looped. The day's competition will conclude with an evening superOES near the Silesian Stadium. For the second day of the rally, the organisers have planned two double-run trials. The Kiczyce SS should be familiar from the previous editions of the Silesian Rally, while the Ochaby section is new. At Kiczyce SS, a section of the route will be driven as a loop. The entire rally will therefore consist of 12 special stages with a total length of 150 km.

The Silesia Rally is a round of the Polish Rally Championship, the Motul Poland Historic Rally Championship and the Southern Rally Championship. This year the event will also have an international focus. The Silesia Rally is a round of the FIA European Rally Trophy (FIA ERT) and the FIA Central European Zone (FIA CEZ) championship.

SERVICE PARK

LOCATION

The service park of the Silesia Rally will be located on the grounds of the Silesian Stadium (ul. Katowicka 10, 41-500 Chorzów).

ENTRY AND EXIT FROM THE SERVICE PARK – RESTRICTIONS

Only authorised vehicles labelled with the "Service", "Auxiliary Vehicle" and "Tyre Fitting Area" (only for the time of loading and unloading wheels and tools) markings and crew starting numbers are allowed to enter the Service Area (accessible through Gate No. 8 from Chorzowska Street — National Road No. 79), (Thursday), from 12:00 noon. All team cars may only park inside their own service area, in accordance with Art. 13.11 of the Polish Rally Championship 2023 Regulations. It is forbidden to park the auto transport trailer(s) and service and accompanying vehicles elsewhere in the Service Park. Any such parking noted by the Service Park staff will result in an additional charge for the space occupied by the vehicle(s).

The plate is to be STICKED on the windscreen on the right side otherwise the car will not be allowed into the service park.

The organiser informs that for safety reasons on 8 September (Friday), from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., on 9 September (Saturday), from 6:00 a.m. to midnight and on 10 September (Sunday), from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., the movement of any vehicle in the Service Park will be prohibited (except for vehicles displaying a SERVICE, AUXILIARY VEHICLE or ORGANISER plate). In addition, the organiser recommends that vehicles be parked outside the Service Park in designated and marked areas. Parking of auto transport trailers is prohibited in the Service Park.

In the event of an emergency, please contact the Service Park Manager.

SERVICE AREA

In the Service Park the competitor is obliged to carry out servicing within the designated service area. The Service Park Manager will check the space occupied by the competitor. Any cases of occupation of a larger service area will result in charging a double fee for additional space in the Service Park, i.e. 50 PLN/m² for private competitors and 70 PLN/m² for legal competitors. Teams are requested to leave the Service area in a condition not requiring cleaning by the Organiser's staff.

ENVIRONMENT PROTECTION

All competitor are obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp (size 4x6 m; thickness min. 0,5 mm) on their service area (under serviced cars). Any damages to the surface of the Service Park have to be avoided.

MAXIMUM SPEED

Maximum speed inside the Service Park is limited by 30 km/h. Failure to comply with this limit shall result in a penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course as follows: 50 PLN per km/h over the speed limit.

CATERING WITHIN THE SERVICE PARK

Apart from the provision of a catering service for the drivers and service crew personnel of a team, any other form of catering or sale of food and beverages in the service park is prohibited. The only exception is possible when a written agreement has been signed between a team and the Organisers. A fine of 4 000 PLN will be applied in case of any infringement of this regulation.



TYRE FITTING AREA

LOCATION

The Tyre Fitting Area (TFA) will be located at the car park of the Bielsko-Biała Municipal Stadium, ul. Tadeusza Rychlińskiego 19, 43-300 Bielsko-Biała

ENTERING AND LEAVING THE CAR PARK AT THE TYRE FITTING AREA

Only authorised vehicles labelled with "Tyre Fitting Area" markings and the relevant crew starting numbers are permitted to enter the car park at the Service Area's Tyre Fitting Area. The workstation in the Tyre Fitting Area must only be used for the time necessary to carry out the activities permitted there and then be vacated immediately so that it can be used by the next crew.

Markings must be STICKED to the windscreen on the right-hand side or else the car will not be allowed into the car park at the Tyre Fitting Area.

ACCESSING THE TYRE FITTING AREA AND PERMITTED WORK

All TFA work may only be carried out by the crew and no more than one team member per crew, using only the equipment carried in the crew's rally car. Team members may bring an extra car jack and four jack stands into the TFA. Only team members with a crew badge bearing a crew starting number will be allowed to work on the car in the Tyre Fitting Area.

OTHER

The rules on speed and catering in the Tyre Fitting Area are the same as those in force in the Service Area.

FUEL/TYRES

FUEL

All type of fuel must follow Appendix J Art. 252.9. (RRSR Art. 62).

TYRES

For all national classes tyres used by the crew during the Rally must comply with Art. 14 of the 2023 RSMP Sporting Regulations. During the Rally, all used tires will be checked and marked in accordance with the above-mentioned regulations. Tyres that do not have the E approval mark must comply with the above-mentioned regulations. Hand cutting of tyres is not allowed, with the exception of national classes if the national regulations allow it.

TYRE WARMING ZONE (TWZ)

There will be a Tyre Warming Zones according to Art. 44.4 of the RRSR before SS1/2 Gmina Jasienica Wiślica and SS 9/11 Ochaby.



RECONNAISSANCE

ISSUE OF DOCUMENTS

On 6 September 2023 (Wednesday), between 05:00 p.m. and 09:00 p.m., documents will be issued at the Rally Office for competitors registered for the rally to learn about the rally route. Crews will be issued with, among other things: the Road Book, the Reconnaissance Card for the rally route, plates with numbers for the reconnaissance car.

RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance will take place on 7 September (Thursday), from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., according to the schedule attached as Appendix 2 to the Supplementary Regulations. Reconnaissance of the OSS1 route in Katowice may be conducted on 7 September 2023 (Thursday), at any time or on 8 September 2023 (Friday), until 3:00 p.m. and reconnaissance of the OSS8 Silesian Stadium route may be conducted on 8 and 9 September 2023 (Thursday and Friday), at any time. The reconnaissance of the route of OSS1 in Katowice and the OSS8 Silesian Stadium can only be carried out on foot. The reconnaissance of the route of the Bieruń-ERG test section may be conducted on 7 September 2023 (Thursday), at any time, observing traffic regulations.

SPECIFIC REGULATIONS

Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during reconnaissance. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Maximum speed allowed during Reconnaissance is 70 km/h on special stages, unless a lower speed limit is indicated by traffic signs or by written instructions in the Road Book or Bulletin.

Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic, except in cases described in Recce Road Book but they must maintain an extreme caution. The speed limit on this part of stages during reconnaissance is 40 km/h

The Organiser will control the Reconnaissance and adherence to the Polish Traffic Law as well as the other regulations, especially Art. 34.2 FIA RRSR and this Supplementary Regulations. The crews must show appropriate documents at the request of the Organiser's representatives or Police Officers and must execute their instructions and commands. The inspections of the special stages will be conducted on regular basis also before the Reconnaissance.

Any member of team (competitor, driver and/or co-driver, support personnel) participating or intending to participate in the rally, which will be found present at the any rally SS route before time of Reconnaissance, will be considered a person performing forbidden Reconnaissance (this regulation does not apply to SSS 1 Katowice and SSS 8 Silesian Stadium).

SCRUTINEERING, SEALING AND MARKING

Each car (in the presence of the competitor or representative named in the registration form) should be presented for BK 1 Scrutineering at the time designated for it. The schedule for BK 1 will be announced on the Virtual Notice Board on the rally website on 4 September 2023 (Monday), at 11:59 p.m.

The BK 1 Scrutineering will take place on 8 September (Friday), from 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

Scrutineering, mandatory documents:

- Scrutineering card (obtained at Administrative Checks),
- Driver's and Co-driver's safety equipment card (downloaded from the rally website, legibly filled in),
- Car's technical passport (FIA or ASN),
- Cars' complete certified FIA homologation form,
- Vehicle registration papers,
- ASN Safety cage certificate, when it's applicable,
- ASN Catalytic converter, when it's applicable.

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

1 Every competitor which wants to use a camera during a rally, this camera must be presented installed in a rally car at the time of Scrutineering. Scrutineers will check if a camera is installed correctly.

PZM-GPS safety tracking system unit will be installed by the PZM-GPS service team just before Scrutineering. Before Scrutineering, all cars must have antenna and system console installed according to instruction. These parts can be obtained from PZM-GPS service team.

Any crew without a system installed in a car will not be able to start in rally and/or Shakedown stage.

Scrutineering for cars that failed to complete Leg 1 and want to start to Leg 2 will be held on Saturday, 9th September 2023 at 06:57, in the Parc Fermé. Cars must be entered into the Parc Fermé until above mentioned time.

Scrutineering for cars that failed to complete Leg 1 and want to start to Leg 2 will be held on Sunday, 10th September 2023 at 07:50, in the Parc Fermé. Cars must be entered into the Parc Fermé until above mentioned time.



SHAKEDOWN

There is an additional charge for the test section.

The Organiser provides a Shakedown stage on Friday, 08.09.2023 from 11:00 till 15:00. Competitor should declare in the entry form his intention to participate in the Shakedown. The cost of participation in the Shakedown is 600 PLN. The Organiser has the right to call Shakedown off if less than 15 applications are received.

Shakedown Stage will be held in Bieruń-ERG, about 35 km from Service Park at the Silesian Stadium in Chorzów. The stage is 2.85 km km in length. During the participation of competitors in Shakedown, service for their cars is only permitted in the additional service in Tychy, Stellantis Test Track.

It is absolutely necessary to follow the road section to the shakedown specified in the road book.

Only cars that have passed the Scrutineering and have mounted fully operational the PZM-GPS safety tracking system can participate in the Shakedown (after paying the fee). Competition numbers and advertising stickers must be affixed to the cars.

Refuelling before Shakedown will be only allowed in Refuelling Area in service park (Silesian Stadium) between 09:00 and 12:00.

Only first driver can drive the car during Shakedown. Team engineer or other person nominated by competitor / driver can be on board of the car during Shakedown if he/she signs a special declaration that he/she participate in shakedown on his/her own risk — responsibility disclaimer. Disclaimer form will be available at the Rally Office and at the Shakedown start. It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal Special Stage. On the Shakedown stage car must stop at the start and stop point to present a Time Card and obtain a permission to drive



CEREMONIAL START

Ceremonial Start Area

September 8th (Friday) Graniczna, 40-020 Katowice

Before the Ceremonial Start there will be a Ceremonial Start Area according to Art. 40.1 of the RRSR.

Competitors must park their cars in Ceremonial Start Area 20 min before their departure time. Departure from Ceremonial Start Area will take place strongly according to the timetable which will be published on Friday, 08.09.2023 at 17:00 on the Digital Notice Board on the rally website — www.rajdslaska.pl. Any delay or early arrival will be penalized by 300 PLN. Cars may be driven by the crew or a representative of the team. All crews taking part in the rally are obliged to follow the marshals instructions in the Start Area. After leaving the Start Area the crews must go directly to the Ceremonial Start, following the route described in the Road Book.

Opening Ceremony

September 8th (Friday), 18:40 Dworcowa, 40-012 Katowice

The crews must wear overalls and attend the Ceremonial Start with their competition cars. If any crew is unable to participate in the Ceremonial Start because of technical problems with their car, they will be permitted to start into the Leg 1 at TC 0 in its allocated start time on condition of notification to the Clerk of the Course and passing the obligatory Rescrutineering Checks. The concerned crew must attend the Ceremonial Start wearing overalls at their due time anyway.

Ceremonial Start

September 8th (Friday), 19:00 Dworcowa, 40-012 Katowice

The Start List for the Ceremonial Start will be published on Friday, 08.09.2023 at 17:00 on the Digital Notice Board on the rally website – www.rajdslaska.pl. The crews will start from the lowest to the highest starting numbers.



FINISH PROCEDURES

Ceremonial Finish

September 10th (Sunday), 16:30 Silesian Stadium

The competition part of the rally ends at TC 12E (Parc Fermé – In). Podium Ceremony and Prize Giving will be held after TC 12D. First three crews of the rally will be awarded on the podium. Other prizes according to the Art. 14 of these Supplementary Regulations will be over-given on the finish ramp. After the Ceremonial Finish, crews are obliged to go straight to the Parc Fermé.

During Ceremonial Start and Finish of the rally, the crews (driver and co-driver) are not allowed to be accompanied at the podium by members of their team or any other people. Displaying advertising elements such as flags, banners, umbrellas etc., as well as distributing advertising materials is forbidden.

Polish Rally Championship (RSMP) uses accreditation admitting criteria for the television, radio, press and internet in accordance with the rules set by the International Automobile Federation (FIA) and the Polish ASN (PZM).

ACCREDITATION RULES AND PROCEDURES:

- 1. The organizer of the rally and the RSMP Media Coordinator are responsible for accreditation of Polish and foreign media representatives.
- 2. Media representatives apply for accreditation on-line. The link to the accreditation application is posted in the media section of the official website of the organiser of the respective Polish Rally Championship round.
- 3. Accreditations for public media that intend to report the RSMP round are free.
- 4. Accreditations are available only for professional journalists, photojournalists and cameramen.
- 5. Accreditation is granted to media representatives as their working tool and cannot be passed on to third-parties and used for PR, advertising or other promotional or commercial activities. Media accreditations are not granted to representatives of sponsors, organizers, suppliers, teams and competitors.
- 6. Accreditations are limited to two representatives of one publishing house, press agency, radio station or internet portal. Only one representative of the institution could receive a PHOTO accreditation.
- 7. One application concerns only one accreditation. The decision concerning the application will be sent to the person applying for accreditation via e-mail. Incomplete application forms (with missing data) will not be considered.
- 8. Independent journalists can also obtain the accreditation for the media, by proving firstly their previous publications on motorsports, especially about RSMP rounds. Publications should be sent in electronic form to the following e-mail address: media@rajdslaska.pl
- 9. Deadlines for sending on-line accreditation forms (and publications in the case of situation described in point 8) to the Rally Silesia 2023 shall end on Friday, September 1st, 2023.
- 10. Accredited media representatives are required to use the correct names of the Polish Rally Championship (RSMP) and all rounds of the series (Rally Silesia 2023).
- 11. The organizer reserves the right to withdraw accreditation to this, who violate safety regulations during the rally.

- Try to reduce noise in the service park
- Do not use disposable plastic dishes and cutlery
- Washing of rally cars is only allowed in designated areas
- Limit the use of cars: move on foot, on bicycles or scooters
- Use public transport: the special stages in Katowice and Chorzów can be conveniently reached by tram or bus

COMMUNICATION



Efforts to create a metropolis in the centre of the Silesian Voivodeship took as long as 20 years. The establishment of the **Upper Silesian Metropolitan Union**, that included 14 of the largest cities in Silesia, in 2006 was an important step in this direction. In 2018, a law was signed which established the Upper Silesian and Zagłębie (GZM) Metropolis. It was divided into five sub-regions: bytomski, gliwicki, katowicki, sosnowiecki and tyski. Katowice became the seat of the GMZ authorities.

The Upper Silesian and Zagłębie Metropolis is made up of 41 cities and municipalities with a total area of 2,500 km², 2.3 million inhabitants and 240,000 companies and businesses.

The GZM is above all well-organised public transport, i.e.:

- a common train, bus and tram ticket,
- convenient connections, thanks to which one can get to almost any place in the agglomeration,
- a bus connection with the nearest airport Katowice-Pyrzowice,
- development of cycling infrastructure,
- development of modern railways.

RALLY SILESIA HISTORY

The Silesia Rally continues the tradition of the Mikołów Rally (later the Mikołów and Żory Rally) – a round of the Silesia Rally Championship. In 2017, Automobilklub Ziemi Tyskiej – the organiser of these events – was offered the opportunity to organise a round of the Polish Rally Championship. Since then, the Silesia Rally has been a permanent fixture on the Polish Championship calendar. Since the first edition, the rally's base has been the Silesian Stadium, a multifunctional facility located in the heart of the Silesian metropolis. Special stages are set in the south of the voivodeship, in the vicinity of Jastrzębie-Zdrój, Skoczów and Cieszyn. In 2023, the rally will be organised in an international format, as a round of the FIA European Rally Trophy.

WELCOME TO SILESIA!

For years associated mainly with heavy industry, the **Silesian Voivodeship** is slowly being disenchanted and rediscovered. Few people know that the Silesian Voviodeship is one of the most forested voivodeships in the country.

The Silesian Voivodeship has undergone a thorough metamorphosis in recent years. It delights with its cultural and tourist values. More and more places associated with the voivodeship's industrial character, seemingly doomed to oblivion, are opening up to visitors. An example is the thematic **Industrial Monuments Route** presenting the industrial heritage of the region – e.g. mining, metallurgy, energy industry and railways. The route is a unique proposal that distinguishes the region on the tourist map of Poland and Europe. It includes, among others, the historic **Guido Coal Mine in Zabrze**, the **Silver Mine in Tarnowskie Góry**, the **Szombierki Combined Heat and Power Plant in Bytom** and the **Żywiec Brewery**. The Silesian lands also hide many monuments, sometimes really old. It is enough to look at the castles on the **Trail of the Eagles' Nests**, the history of which dates back to the 14th century.







The potential of the voivodeship is not only its history, but also its terrain. The proximity of the Silesian and Żywiec Beskids allows short trips to the Czantoria, Babia Góra or Pilsko mountains. The region's residents enjoy them regardless of the season. In winter, numerous ski lifts attract skiing lovers.

There are also places for climbing, with the rocks of the Kraków-Częstochowa Upland being the true haven. Lovers of water attractions can spend time by the numerous lakes – including Żywieckie Lake, Międzybrodzkie Lake, Pogoria Lakes or the more intimate Paprocańskie Lake.



SILESIAN STADIUM

The Silesian Stadium is the central point of the rally. It was designed by architect Julian Brzuchowski. A huge contribution to its construction was made by fans, who worked as volunteers. The official inauguration took place on 22 July 1956 during a friendly football match between Poland and East Germany, lost by our team 0:2. The Stadium quickly became the place for major events of national importance. Our national football team has played more than 50 matches here. Celebrities such as Pelé, Cristiano Ronaldo and David Beckham have run on the pitch. Our national football legends such as Gerard Cieślik, Włodzimierz Lubański and Grzegorz Lato also played there. The Stadium was also the place of speedway races. It has hosted participants and fans of individual, team and pairs world finals seven times, and in 1973 Jerzy Szczakiel won gold here. Athletes competed on it, and Irena Szewińska equalled her world record in the 200 m run. The Silesian Stadium is also famous for concerts, attracting up to 85,000 fans. The Rolling Stones, Metallica, AC/DC, The Police, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Linkin Park, Pearl Jam and Genesis have all performed there. The last concert before the renovation was given by U2. After that – in 2018 and 2019 – the Silesian Stadium was visited by, among others, Guns N' Roses and Rammstein. After modernisation and the introduction of modern sound and lighting systems, the facility is back to its greatness.



KATOWICE

The history of Katowice dates back to the 16th century. Today's centre of the Silesian agglomeration was then an agricultural centre. From the second half of the 19th century, Katowice entered the era of industrialisation, developing at an incredible pace. To this day, the city is associated mainly with the mining industry. In fact, it is not only an important centre for new technologies, but also provides a wide range of entertainment and cultural events, both for its residents and regular visitors from all over Europe. In Katowice, it is worth visiting Mariacka Street, which is full of bars and restaurants, the picturesque, renovated market square, the Silesian Museum, the Spodek arena, known throughout Poland, the building of the Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra, as well as the International Congress Centre, which hosts many cultural events. However, if you are looking for some relaxation in nature, it is worth going to the Valley of Three Ponds or to the Silesian Park located on the border with Chorzów, where you will find, among other things, the Silesian Zoo.

Katowice regularly hosts many cultural events, among other things, music festivals (Tauron, Rawa Blues, OFF Festival) and theatre festivals (A Part, Katowice Dzieciom), as well as the Intel Extreme Masters e-sports festival, which attracts participants from all over the world. There are organisations that support the development of culture in Katowice, such as Katowice Miasto Ogrodów (Katowice – City of Gardens).



SILESIAN PARK





The Silesian Park is comparable in size to New York's Central Park. It is located on the border of Katowice and Chorzów, which gives it excellent accessibility: it is easily accessible by car, bicycle or public transport. This wonderful place allows you to take a break from the city and get closer to nature. It is attractive both to those who prefer relaxation in the form of a picnic or family barbecue and to those who relax in an active way: the park is full of bicycle paths, routes for inline skaters and places for running. There is also the zoo and planetarium in the Silesian Park. The possibility of renting a pedal boat and riding it on the pond, or the option of taking a cable car up to the Silesian Stadium, makes that you will never be bored in the Silesian Park. If you are in need of a stronger stimulus, there is the Silesian Amusement Park right next to the park, which can provide you with a lot of excitement.

THE SPODEK ARENA



The Spodek was opened in the heart of Katowice in 1971 and has been a symbol of the city ever since. Various sporting and cultural events take place there, including the growing popularity of the Intel Extreme Masters e-sports championships, as well as concerts by global stars. In winter, part of the Spodek Arena turns into an ice rink.



SILESIAN MUSEUM

This Museum was established in 1929 – it has changed its seat many times over a period of 90 years. The new building complex is located on the former site of the Katowice Coal Mine. On three levels, hidden underground, there are rich collections of works of art.

BUILDING OF THE POLISH NATIONAL RADIO SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA (NOSPR)

A modern building located in the centre of Katowice, adjacent to the Spodek, has become the beginning of a new cultural district in the city. The building of the Polish National Radio Symphony Orchestra was constructed on a post-industrial site and the adjacent herb garden is a symbol of the richness of the Silesian land. There are regular performances by world-famous stars, and the building itself is known for its perfect acoustics.



NIKISZOWIEC

The housing estate built in the early 20th century for the miners of the Giesche mine. According to a comprehensive design by Emil and Georg Zillmann, Nikiszowiec was to be fully self-sufficient. The housing estate consists of nine large buildings with a characteristic geometry and large, green courtyards. The brick facades and red-painted windows are an iconic picture of this part of the city. Today, the "Nikisz" is an extremely popular place, attracting many interesting events and festivals.

THE "MACIEJ" SHAFT

The "Maciej" shaft is a complex of buildings of the former "Concordia" Coal Mine in Zabrze-Maciejów. The complex, which was built at the beginning of the 20th century, worked until the coal deposits were exhausted, but fortunately did not share the fate of many Silesian mines. The "Maciej" shaft has been preserved, restored in a modern style and given a new role. The shaft itself has been transformed into a deep well, and the remaining buildings into a living museum where you can not only learn about the history of mining technology, but also have a good lunch in an unusual scenery.



GUIDO COAL MINE

The former coal mine, founded in 1855 by Guido Henckel von Donnersmarck, was still in operation as an experimental plant in the 1960s . It is now open to tourists – it is part of the Coal Mining Museum in Zabrze. Sightseeing the mine is possible on three levels, there is also a version for those persistent – in full mining equipment. In the mine there is also a park and a museum of military technology, and in the very underground there are a restaurant and an art gallery.

BLACK TROUT ADIT

A miner's boat tour through a 600-metre-long, narrow underground adit is one of Upper Silesia's best-known attractions. The Black Trout Adit has been operating as a tourist facility for over 60 years. The former adit of the "Fryderyk" lead-silver ore mine is today part of a tourist complex that also includes the silver mine in Tarnowskie Góry. Since 2017, the entire site, together with its drainage systems, water supply infrastructure and numerous cultural landscapes, has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

OGRODZIENIEC CASTLE

One of the symbols of the Kraków-Częstochowa Upland was built on the initiative of King Casimir the Great. During the Deluge, it was set on fire twice and never regained its former glory. Today, the Ogrodzieniec Castle, as a permanent ruin, attracts tourists not only by its magnitude, but also by the wealth of events and cultural activities that take place within its walls.

BĘDZIN CASTLE

Built in the mid-14th century by Casimir the Great as a defensive stronghold. The castle was part of the system of the so-called Eagles' Nests. Over the centuries, it was destroyed many times, and at the beginning of the 20th century, it was already an uninhabited ruin. After the Second World War, a decision was made to rebuild the castle. Today, there is the Zagłębie Museum with a rich collection of exhibits..



BOBOLICE CASTLE

Built by Casimir the Great around 1350, the castle is classified as the stronghold of the Eagles' Nests. It was supposed to defend the Kingdom of Poland against the invasion from Silesia. In 1999, the castle was purchased by a private investor that rebuilt it from ruins and transformed it into a hotel and museum. The legend says that after dark, the Lady in White walks through the castle in search of her beloved....



BŁĘDÓW DESERT

The desert, which is situated on the border between the Silesian and Lesser Poland Voivodeships, is called the Polish Sahara. It covers an area of 32 km2 and even at the beginning of the 20th century, sandstorms were observed in this area. The Błędów Desert is not a natural creation – its creation was caused by intensive deforestation in the 13th century. The desert was often used as a training ground for military units. The uniqueness of the area was also used, among others, during the filming of "In Desert and Wilderness (Polish: W pustyni i w puszczy)".
